Procedures to Access School Campus

Follow the procedures detailed below to access school campus:

- 1) Fill out the google form ([San Miguel Sign In](#)) **24 hrs. in advance** to request access to campus. The information from this form is given to custodial staff to have rooms unlocked and office staff to be aware of those on campus for emergency response purposes. <https://forms.gle/1grq9EkJQpFkwdoQ8>
- 2) For the health screening, you can download the Power App (Daily Pass App) to your mobile or you can log into the link below: <https://achieve.lausd.net/covidtesting> to access the Daily Pass. Click on "schedule your appointment" then it will take you to another page. You will then see a live link for Daily Pass. This is to be completed the morning you are planning to enter campus. This is part of the health screening process.
- 3) When you come onto campus, you must show the Welcomer proof of health screening completion (Daily Pass App or photo from the health screening). After proof of Daily Pass is shown to the Welcomer, then your temperature will be taken. All staff will get their temperature checked when they arrive. Depending on the health screening (Daily Pass App or district site Daily Pass) and the temperature check, you may or may not be allowed entrance to campus.
- 4) Email administrators when you leave campus at the end of the day.
